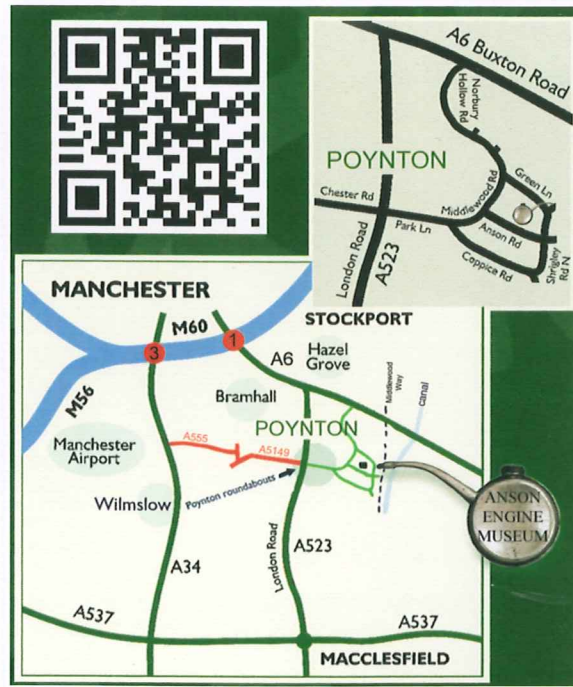

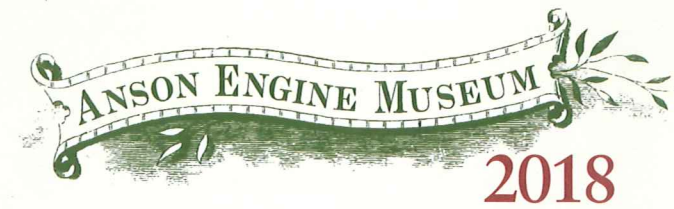

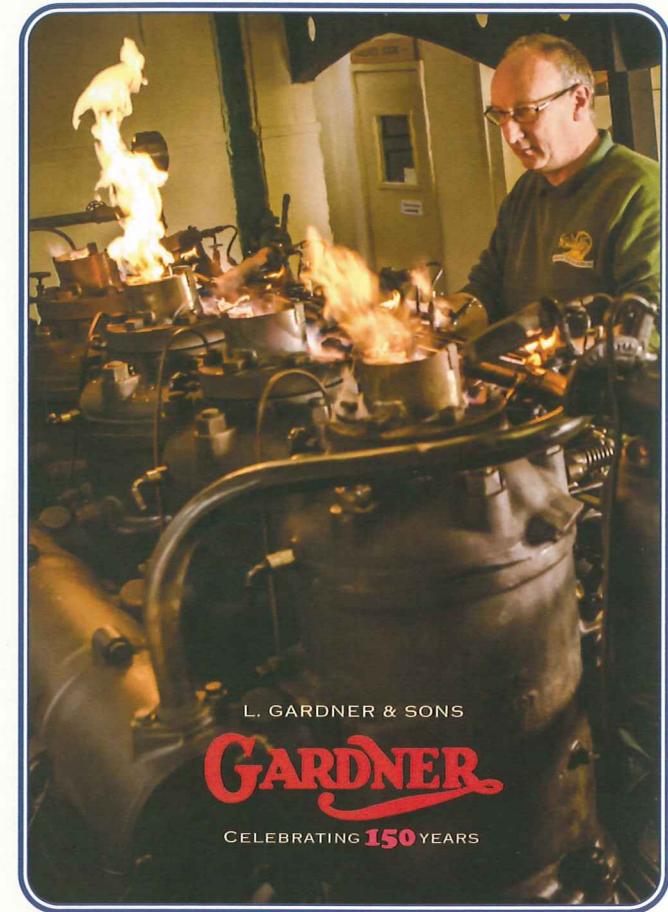

Follow brown tourist signs from Poynton roundabouts. **By bus:** Take the P1 from Hazel Grove to the Boars Head Higher Poynton, then a 10 minutes walk down Anson Road to the museum. **Train station:** Middlewood 1.3 miles Poynton 2 miles. **By Canal:** From bridge no.15. **Walk:** 15 minute from the Middlewood Way and Macclesfield Canal.



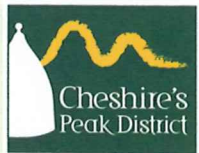
